Mission:

To pioneer a whole person vision for creative aging which empowers every person to realize their health potential through all stages of life.

Vision Statement

To enable longevity by inspiring healthy living at every age. To break the age barrier and inspire people to live a healthy, long life that is fulfilling, independent, and happier...ultimately leaving a legacy that will blaze a trail for the next generation.

Strategic Goal:

The goal of the Consortium is to form collaborations with companies that have the infrastructure, resources, and commitment needed to develop actionable solutions for creative aging, in both health and healing.

The lead founders of the Consortium, Scripps Translational Science Institute and IQ Orlando, which includes the Tavistock Group, Florida Hospital, University of Central Florida and the AHG Group, seek to convene likeminded organizations to collaborate and develop transcendent ideas that produce groundbreaking solutions focused on improving the aging process.

The founders bring two innovative communities to the Consortium to serve as "living laboratories" for rapid development and testing of solutions. These communities include Celebration, Florida, designed by Disney, and Lake Nona Medical City, the largest green field health community development in the nation, designed by the Tavistock Group. Additionally, Florida Hospital's Health Village, a 172 acre urban medical innovation district in Orlando, Florida, provides a platform for the rapid translation of ideas in a healing environment.

2016 Lake Nona Impact Forum: Announcement of the Consortium:

At this year's Impact Forum, the two founding members of the Consortium, Scripps Translational Science Institute and IQ Orlando, announced the formation of the Consortium for Creative Aging, outlined the goals and vision for the group, and presented a call-to-action opportunity for other convening companies to become part of the movement.

A specific follow-up to the announcement will be an invitation to attend a strategic visioning session that will be held in Spring 2016 at Lake Nona Medical City and Florida Hospital Health Village.

Spring 2016: Vision Session & Document:

Convening companies that are interested in taking this next step can coordinate their attendance at the Vision Session through a Consortium founding company.

Convening Company Qualifications:

In order to qualify for participation in the Consortium, companies must:

- 1. Have an expressed focus on creative aging in their strategic priorities
- 2. Have leadership engaged and dedicated to advancing this priority
- 3. Have dedicated budgets to advance thought into action

Convening companies have a common commitment and realize the need to create a system that cares for the whole person, mind, body and spirit. These companies specialize in relationship-rich, enabling technologies and solutions. They understand the need for collaboration and network development.

Future Announcements:

After confirming full participation of the convening companies, the Consortium will make a formal announcement of all participating companies and the overall strategic plan and goals of the group. This announcement is expected to be made in late summer of 2016.
